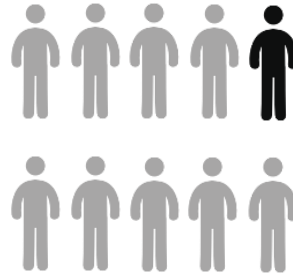

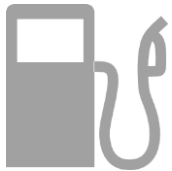
## ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

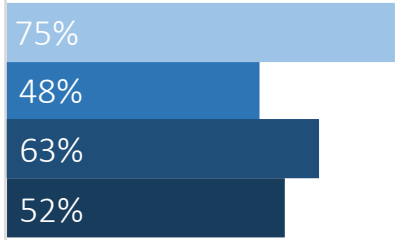


of Brits think that **freezing the fuel duty** will be beneficial to them.

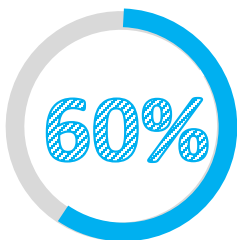

Depending on voting intent, the belief in policies differs, for example in spending £2 billion on **flood defences** in affected areas.

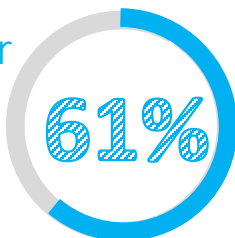


## WORKABLE POLICIES
