

General Election Vote Intention: Multilevel regression and post-stratification (MRP) estimates *

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This report provides estimates of vote intention in each parliamentary constituency in the UK (excluding Northern Ireland) using data collected between 26th and 30th September, 2022. The report was prepared on behalf of Opinium by Jack Blumenau, University College London.

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Methods

Data Collection

The estimates presented here are based on a survey of 10495 respondents, which was fielded between 26th and 30th September 2022.

Model

Constructing constituency-level estimates of vote intention (or any other survey response) is complicated by the fact that the number of constituencies is large and the number of observations in any given constituency is small. Even with the relatively large national sample that we have here (just over 10,000 respondents), we have just 17 observations per constituency on average. As a consequence, there are not enough observations in each constituency to treat the data as separate constituency polls.

Instead, the approach we adopt here – known as multilevel regression and post-stratification (MRP) – looks for patterns in the survey responses across constituencies that have similar characteristics, and then works out the implications of those patterns for the expected vote shares of each party in each constituency.

We proceed in three steps:

1. **Population model**

- The population model is a description of which kinds of people live in which places in the UK. We decompose the population according to a set of characteristics – age, gender, working status, level of education, prior voting history, etc – and calculate the number of people of each type in each constituency. For example, the population model tells us the number of women aged between 30 and 44, with degree-level education, who voted for Labour in 2019, voted Remain in 2016, and who live in the North East Hertfordshire

constituency. It also tells us the number of men aged 65+ who have GSCE-level education, who voted Conservative in 2019, voted Leave in 2016, and who live in the Surrey Heath constituency. And so on. By describing the full set of voter-types in this way, in each constituency, we can then predict whether people of this type turnout to vote, and which parties they are likely to vote for (see the steps below), and thus generate predictions for the election outcome as a whole. We use a number of data sources to construct the population model, including census data, previous election results, and survey data.

2. Turnout model

- The turnout model generates estimates of the probability that voters of each type will turn out to vote in a forthcoming general election. We take a different approach to traditional polling methods, as we do not use respondents' self-declared likelihood of voting to estimate turnout, but instead use data from past elections to predict whether different types of voters are likely to vote. In particular, we use a regression model to estimate the associations between each of the characteristics included in our population model and turnout in prior elections. We then use the model to predict the probability of voting for every type of voter in our population model. This approach has performed reasonably well [in the past](#) and although it is possible that the relationships between demographic characteristics and turnout might change over time, these shifts are [unlikely to be sufficiently large to be consequential for election results](#).

3. Vote-choice model

- The vote-choice model estimates the probability that voters of each type will vote for each party. This model captures how voting intention is associated with individual-level characteristics, such as age, past vote, education, working status, and so on. We again use a regression model to estimate the relationship between vote intention – as expressed in

response to the question described below – and respondent characteristics. We then use the estimated model to predict the probability of voting for candidates of each party for each voter type in our population model. For instance, the survey data might suggest that people with higher educational qualifications, or those living in different parts of the UK, or those with different voting histories, are more likely to vote for certain parties. By using the model to describe all of these patterns, we are then able to make predictions about how a given type of individual would respond to the survey question on the basis of their characteristics. Once we can make predictions of this form, it is simple to calculate the proportion of people in each constituency who we expect to a) turnout to vote (using our turnout model), and b) vote for each party (using our vote-choice model).

The models we have developed for this project look for patterns in turnout and vote choice as a function of a number of variables, including individual 2019 vote, 2016 referendum vote, sex, age, qualifications, housing tenure, working status, marital status and ethnicity. At the level of constituencies, we look for patterns as a function of the electoral history of the constituency, EU referendum vote, region/country, and several other variables.

We do not report explicit intervals of uncertainty around all of the estimates that we provide below because it makes the tables cumbersome to read. It is also important to note that we can only quantify some of the uncertainty that a reader *ought* to have. The traditional statistical margin of error only includes uncertainty that results from having a limited sample of a population. We provide this for some of the main estimates below. However, as explained above, the estimates presented below are based on multiple models (a population model, a turnout model, and a vote-choice model), and it is very difficult to fully quantify the potential sources of uncertainty that arise in all of these models.

Survey Questions

The question polled was:

The following candidates ran in your constituency at the last general election. If they were to stand in your constituency again at the next election, who would you vote for?

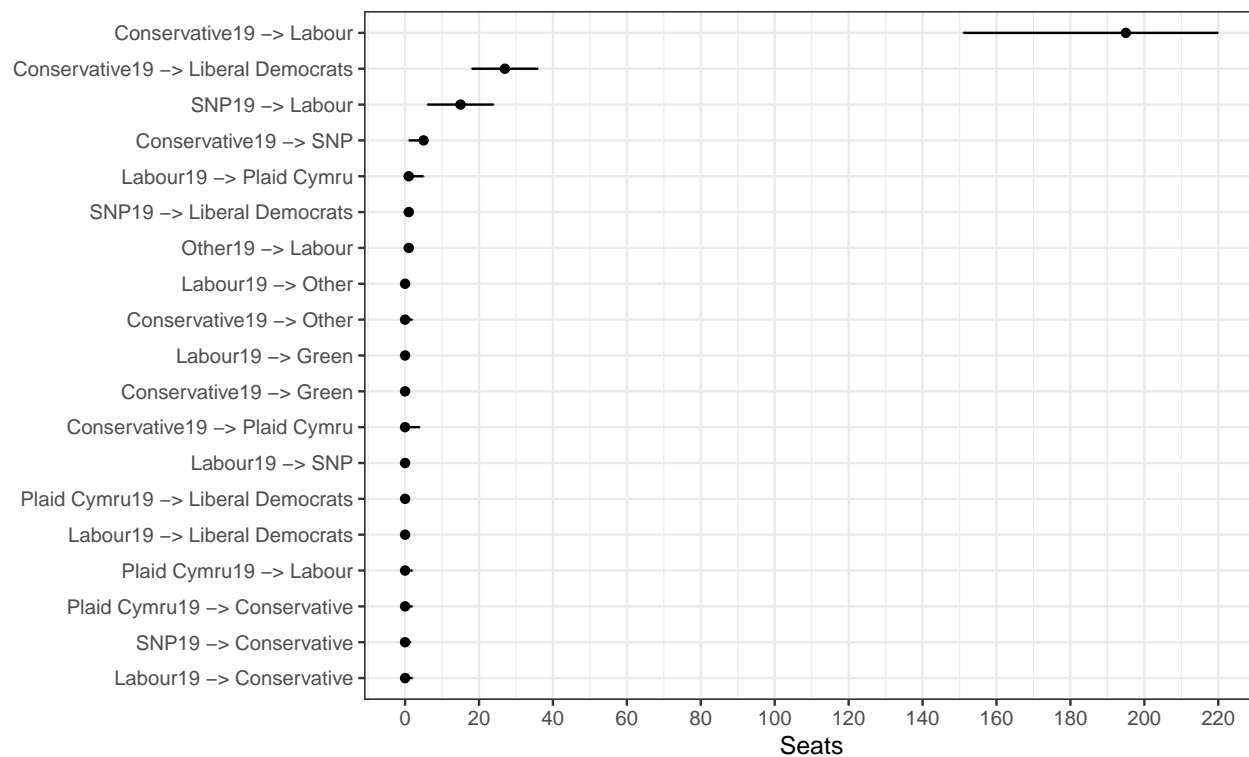

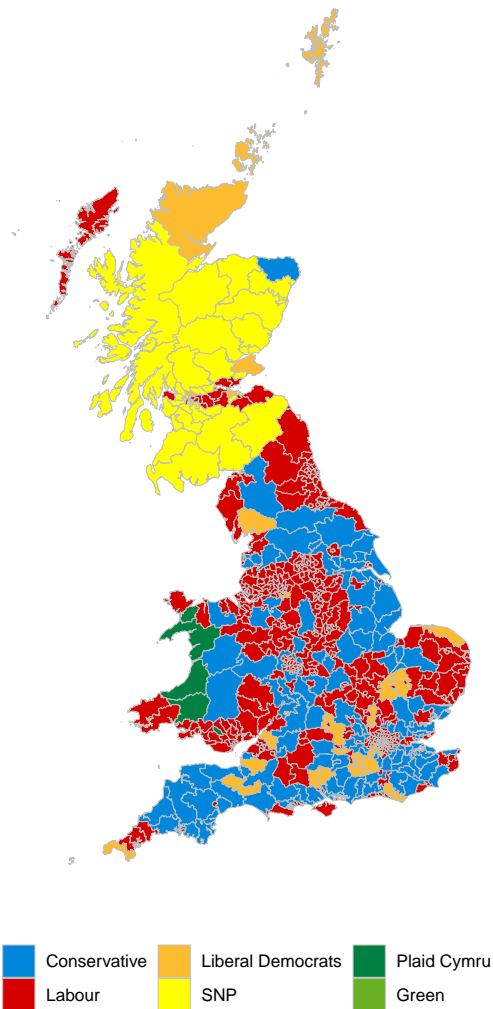

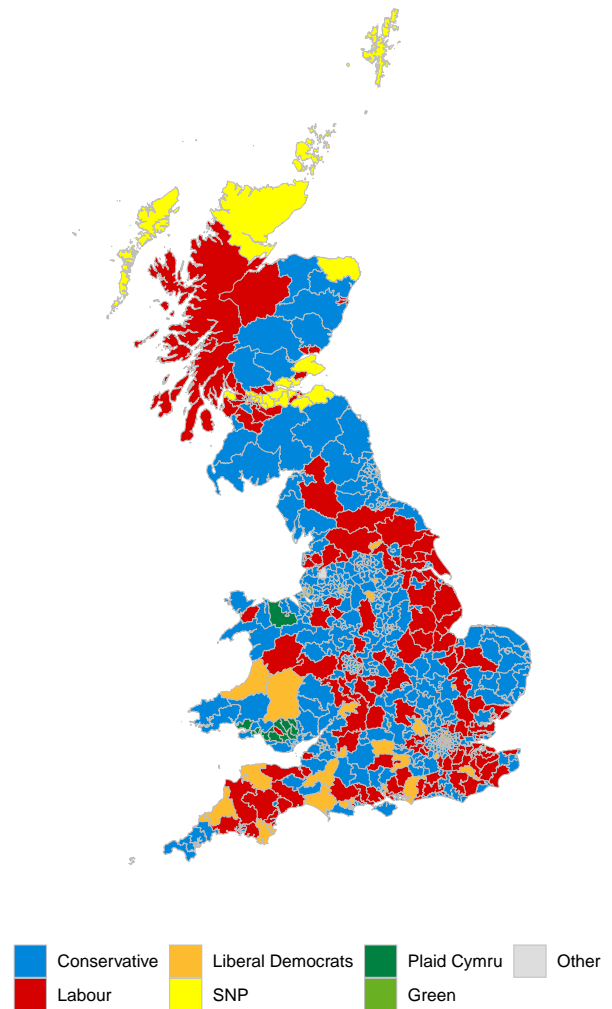

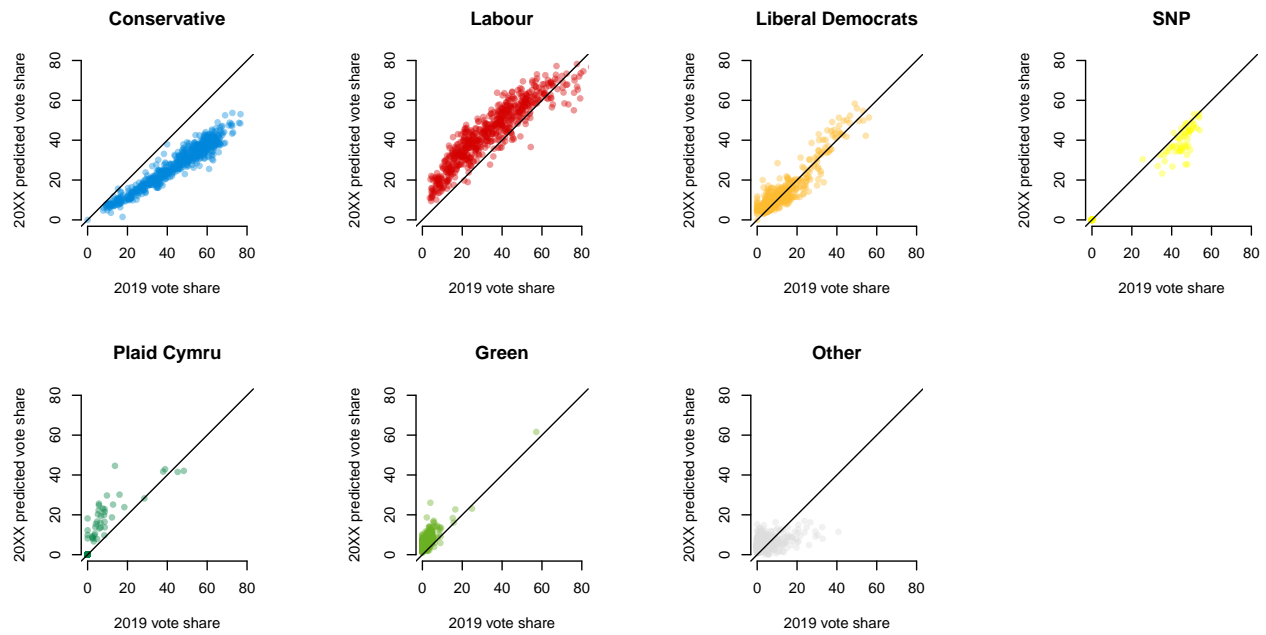


Figure 1: Predicted Constituency Vote Share by 2019 Constituency Vote Share
